

Brighter Futures Community Investment Program Guidelines

Arrow has been supporting communities through our Brighter Futures program since 2011.

Below are guidelines to assist you in considering an application for Brighter Futures community grant funding.

In order to support the communities, we live and work in:

- We partner with local organisations to address local needs
- We invest in small scale one-off initiatives

The majority of applications for Brighter Futures funding are for small scale initiatives and activities (typically valued from \$500 to \$5000 excl. GST).

On occasion, Arrow will consider a higher investment where strong business case has been provided, that meets our business requirements. Further information is available by calling 1800 038 856.

To be eligible for funding applications must:

- Be submitted by a not-for-profit organisation
- Benefit the communities where Arrow operates
 - Surat Basin
 - Bowen Basin and
 - Greater Brisbane region
- Align with one of Arrow's key focus areas
 - Health and Safety
 - Education and
 - Environment

When to apply:

- There are three funding rounds per year that open on:
 - Round 1: first Friday of March
 - Round 2: first Friday of June
 - Round 3: first Friday of September
- Arrow aims to notify applicants of the outcome within (8) weeks of the round closing.

We fund initiatives that:

- Build skills and capacity in the local communities
- Bring communities together and support local businesses
- Deliver ongoing benefits to communities after the initiative is complete

In addition, we are happy to discuss opportunities for Arrow staff to participate.

We do not fund:

- Individuals or organisations that are not eligible recipients
- Initiatives delivered outside of our priority locations and key focus areas
- Requests for capital works or large equipment requiring ongoing maintenance
- On-going running costs including insurance, employee salaries or overheads
- Untied cash donations including prize money

Additional Information:

- All applications are assessed by Arrow's Brighter Futures Committee. The committee will assess, prioritise and make recommendations for funding.
- Due to the high volume of applicants, we regret that we are often unable to provide feedback on individual applications.
- From time to time, Arrow may choose to partner with a larger not-for-profit organisation to deliver initiatives across multiple regions. Applications are considered on a case-by-case basis and require a strong business case.
- Applications must be signed by your organisations accountable officer (i.e. CEO, Chairperson, President)
- All successful applicants are asked to submit a high-quality photo and short story highlighting the positive impact of their initiative.

If your organisation meets these guidelines, we encourage you to complete and submit the online application form.

Arrow acknowledges that some organisations may not have access to the technical resources to apply – please contact our community staff and we would be happy to help you finalise a submission.
