| ITEM 7 | Area Wide Planning and Landholder Layout Agreement | |
| | <p>Chris Wicks described the Area Wide Planning (AWP) pilot process, and how AWP has been incorporated into Arrow's New Gas process. As part of this development Arrow is putting forward a draft proposal to include a pre-CCA Layout Agreement on CSG Infrastructure Layout and including standard specifications, conditions and compensation frameworks.</p> <p>Attendees discussed how AWP could be implemented going forward, and the Layout Agreement proposal. Generally there was endorsement of the plan. Points of discussion included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Size of groups and number of meetings. Chris said that this would be flexible and depend on landholders and local factors. • Compensation as a confidential issue for individual landholders. Chris said that one of the concepts of the Layout Agreement was to focus on infrastructure first, before using the compensation framework to develop a CCA, permitting construction. • Principle of trying to get the best outcome for an area rather than focussing on individual landholders. | Chris Wicks to provide the presentation to IFL members. |
