Road upgrades

Upgrades to Broadwater Road

February 2022



Arrow will upgrade a section of Broadwater Road, south of the Lake Broadwater reserve, as part of the first phase of the Surat Gas Project.

This work is to enable the local road network to safely accommodate the predicted increase in road use as a result of Arrow's activities and improve safety for all road users.

What will the upgrade include?

The unsealed section of the road will be upgraded to sealed bitumen.

While the road will remain open at all times, temporary traffic lights may lead to minor delays for the duration of the upgrade.

The speed limit will be reduced during construction and water trucks will be used to suppress dust.

Works are being undertaken by Arrow's local subcontractor FKG Group who will manage day to day communication with landholders and residents in the area throughout the project.

When will the upgrade happen?

The upgrade has been split into two stages to help alleviate construction impacts for road users and nearby landholders:

- **Stage 1** (~1km) - scheduled to from **early March 2022, 6am – 6pm**
- **Stage 2** (~1.2km) - scheduled from **May/June, 6am – 6pm** (weather permitting).

Landholders adjacent to roadworks have been directly engaged by Arrow to discuss upgrades to property access points and changes to road alignment.

Key design elements:

- Stage 1 including pavement strengthening and widening will be carried out within the existing road reserve. Stage 2 will also include road realignment.
- The upgraded sections will be widened to an eight-metre formation with a seven-metre-wide bitumen seal.
- Traffic management zones will be established around the work front.
- Crossroad drainage has been designed to ensure the upgrade does not impact adjacent overland flow paths and maintains existing floodway levels.

- The scope includes:
 - full re-construction and upgrade of sections of existing unsealed road
 - lime stabilisation and improvement of the subgrade
 - gravel pavement layers
 - spray sealing
 - road signs, guideposts, markers and line-marking
 - replacement of gate, grids and fencing.

Roadwork planning process:

An independent Traffic Management Impact Assessment identified a need for this upgrade to manage the additional traffic volume as a result of Arrow activity. The work is supported by Western Downs Regional Council (WDRC).
