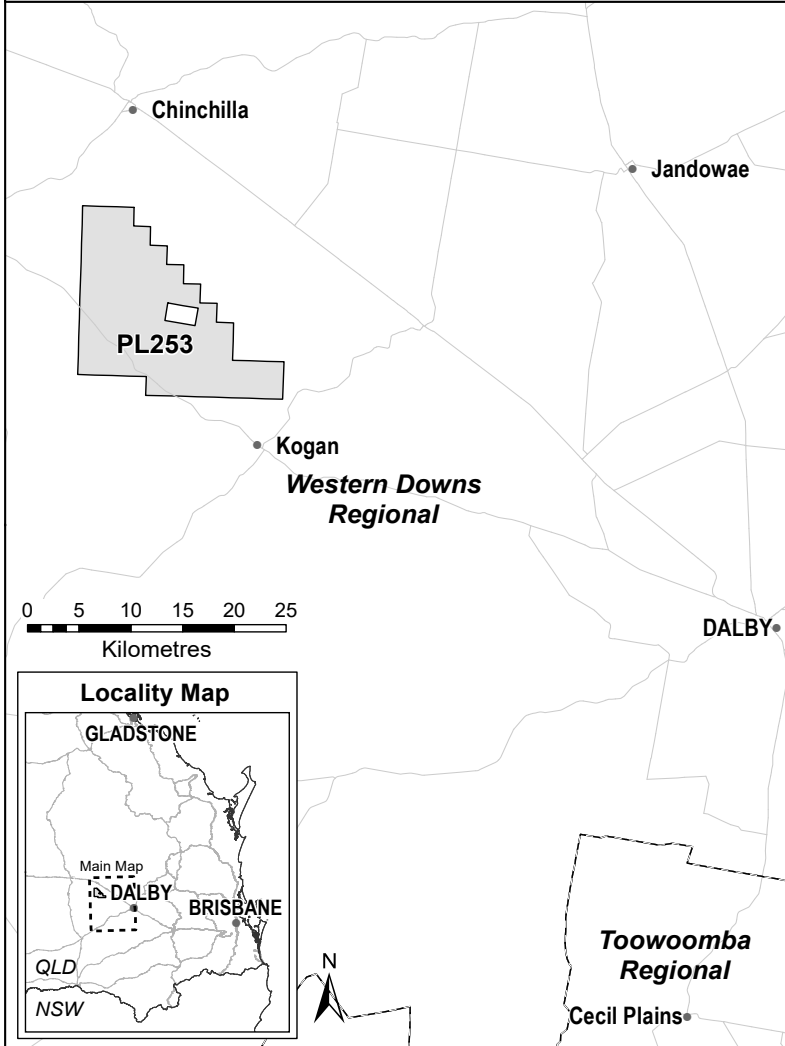


Notification of Environmental Authority (EA) Amendment Application

PL253 Tenement



In accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994, Arrow Energy has lodged an application for an amendment to an existing Environmental Authority (EA0001401) for Petroleum Lease 253 (Hopeland) as part of its Surat Gas Project. The application relates to the construction and operation of coal seam gas (CSG) wells and gathering pipeline within Arrow's Surat Basin CSG fields.

The amendment application seeks the following increases to the currently authorised activities:

- construction and operation of an additional 280 wells
- construction and operation of 440 km of water and gas gathering pipelines
- associated ancillary activities necessary for the construction and operation of the wells and gathering.

Activities are proposed to occur within the area of Petroleum Lease (PL), PL253 (see map).
