


➤ Approval of Underground Water Impact Report for Authority to Prospect 644

The Chief Executive of the Queensland Department of Environment and Science has approved, without conditions, Arrow Energy's final Underground Water Impact Report (UWIR) for Authority to Prospect (ATP) 644.

ATP 644 is in the Clarence-Moreton Basin. Although Arrow withdrew its application to renew ATP 644 on 21 June 2022, a final UWIR was required to complete the withdrawal process. This included making the report available for public consultation from 5 September to 4 October 2022.



The report is the fourth and final UWIR for ATP 644. It follows the previous report, which was published on 8 July 2022.

As described in previous UWIRs, the production wells have been plugged and fully rehabilitated, and no production testing has been undertaken since 2010. As a result, the predictions made in this final report have not changed materially from previous reports.
