

# Assessment Application for a Regional Interests Development Approval *Regional Planning Interests Act 2014 – Have your say*

<b>For:</b>	Arrow Energy Pty Ltd and Arrow CSG (Australia) Pty Ltd are seeking a Regional Interests Development Approval (RIDA) to allow the construction of a tie-in valve and single length of pipe into a pre-existing treated water pipeline, part of the Condamine Alluvium Substitution Scheme (CASS). The project is known as the CASS Tie-in.  The resource activity in this application is the construction of the tie-in valve and a single length of pipeline (12 m). This will extend the future control and connectivity of the CASS to enable distribution of treated water for agricultural uses.  Construction is scheduled to take a maximum of eight weeks, and the infrastructure will be in operation for 10 to 15 years. The maximum area of disturbance to priority agricultural activity due to construction activity is 1.38 hectares. The maximum area of disturbance to priority agricultural activity during operations is 0.82 hectares.
