Gas and renewables to power northern development

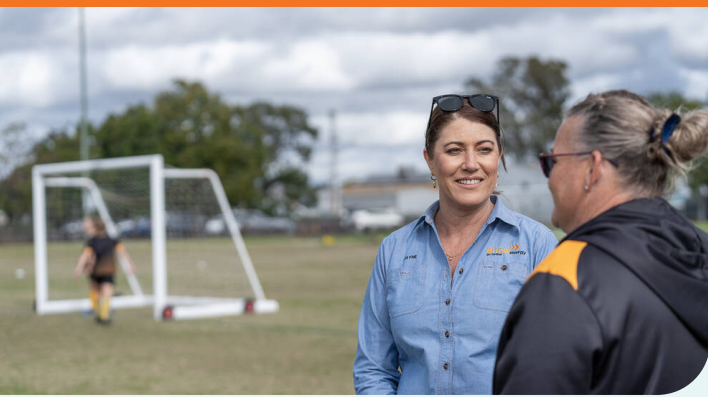
In a strong demonstration of how natural gas and renewables can work together to deliver reliable energy, construction is underway on a hybrid power station near Miles to support our SGP North. The power station, which will be fuelled by a mix of solar, gas and electricity, will provide power to our operations. Once operational in 2027, the facility is expected to supply up to 186 gigawatt hours of electricity per year, with approximately 20 per cent generated from solar.

Sixteen not-for-profit organisations have been awarded a total of almost \$61,000 in funding as part of Arrow Energy's 2026 Brighter Futures community grants program.

Current activities

Natural gas development activities are continuing in the Western Downs throughout 2026 as part of our Surat Gas Project. Work will include the installation of water and gas pipelines, the drilling of gas wells on properties where Arrow holds agreements with landholders, the construction of infrastructure, and road upgrades.

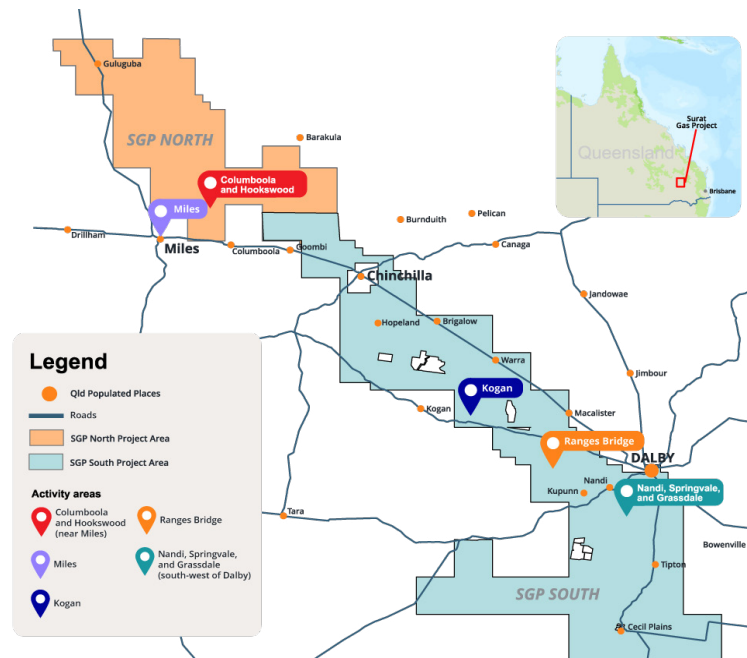
Activity areas

- Nandi, Springvale, Grassdale and Ranges Bridge (Dalby region)

Traffic management

While we carefully manage heavy vehicle movements to minimise disruption to the community, some road users may notice increased use of traffic routes in activity areas.

To support our activities, several oversize equipment loads will be transported from Brisbane to Miles in late March and April. These deliveries will use the Warrego Highway, Leichhardt Highway, and local roads in the Hookwood area.
