Maintenance activities – Arrow Daandine Compression Facility

Arrow Energy will conduct maintenance on its Daandine Central Gas Processing Facility (CGPF) on **Thursday 16 April – Saturday 18 April 2026**. The facility will be shut down and a safety flare will be in use to enable maintenance activities.

Why is it happening?

- Each year Arrow conducts maintenance on its CGPF.
- The facility is shutdown so the maintenance can occur safely.
- A safety flare removes the gas from the facility while maintenance occurs.
- Under the *Petroleum & Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2003*, operators are required to flare where it is safe to do so.
- Flaring is the controlled burning of gas and has a greenhouse effect of ten times less than gas venting.

Where is it happening?

- Arrow's Daandine CGPF off Dalby Kogan Road.
- Residents who live nearby may notice light from the flare, or a soft glow if further away. The flare's appearance will depend on weather conditions.
