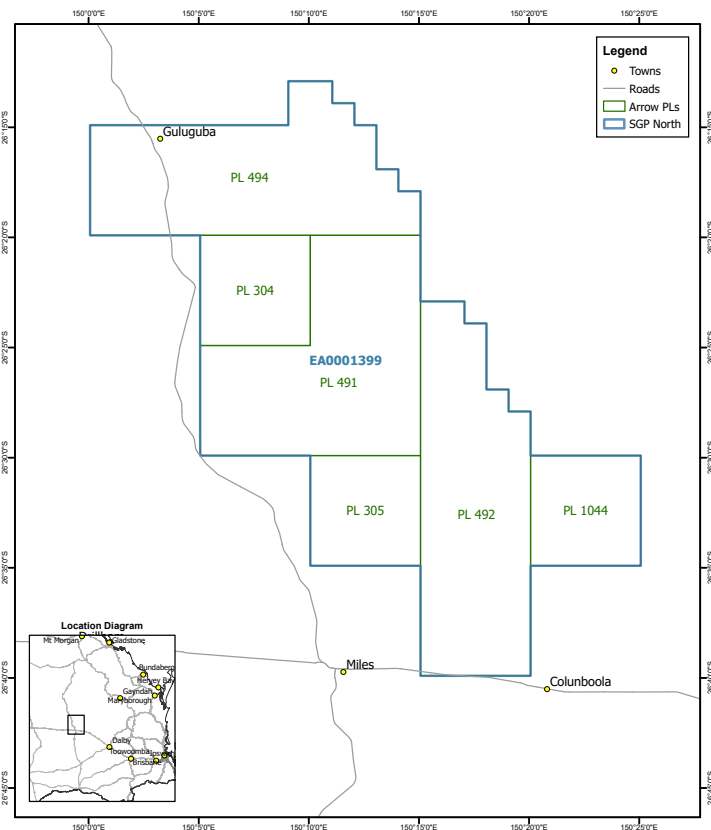


Application notice

SGP North EA (EA0001399) Amendment



SGP North EA locations

Resource activity: Site specific petroleum activity

It is advised that Arrow CSG (Australia) Pty Ltd has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The environmental authority being amended is EA0001399, which applies to the following Petroleum Leases (PL): PL304, PL305, PL491, PL492, PL494 and PL1044, also known as the Surat Gas Project North (SGP North).

The EA amendment application relates to areas of PL491, PL305 and PL492 (refer to map) to facilitate the development of stage 5 of the project.

This amendment does not propose an increase in the scale of petroleum activities beyond what is already approved under EA0001399. Stage 5 is proposed to facilitate the construction of wells, gathering lines, and associated infrastructure. The amendment addresses the on-ground impacts of the Stage 5 footprint, requiring changes to authorised impact areas for Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESAs) and Prescribed Environmental Matters (PEMs). Specifically, the amendment seeks to:

- Authorise increased impacts to PEMs and matters of state environmental significance.
- Authorise increased impacts to Category B and C ESAs, including their Primary and Secondary Protection Zones.

The application documents for the Project consist of the properly made environmental authority amendment application form and supporting information reports with appendices on biodiversity impact assessments and spatial files.
