Environmental Authority Amendment - EA0001401 (Hopeland) Stage 2

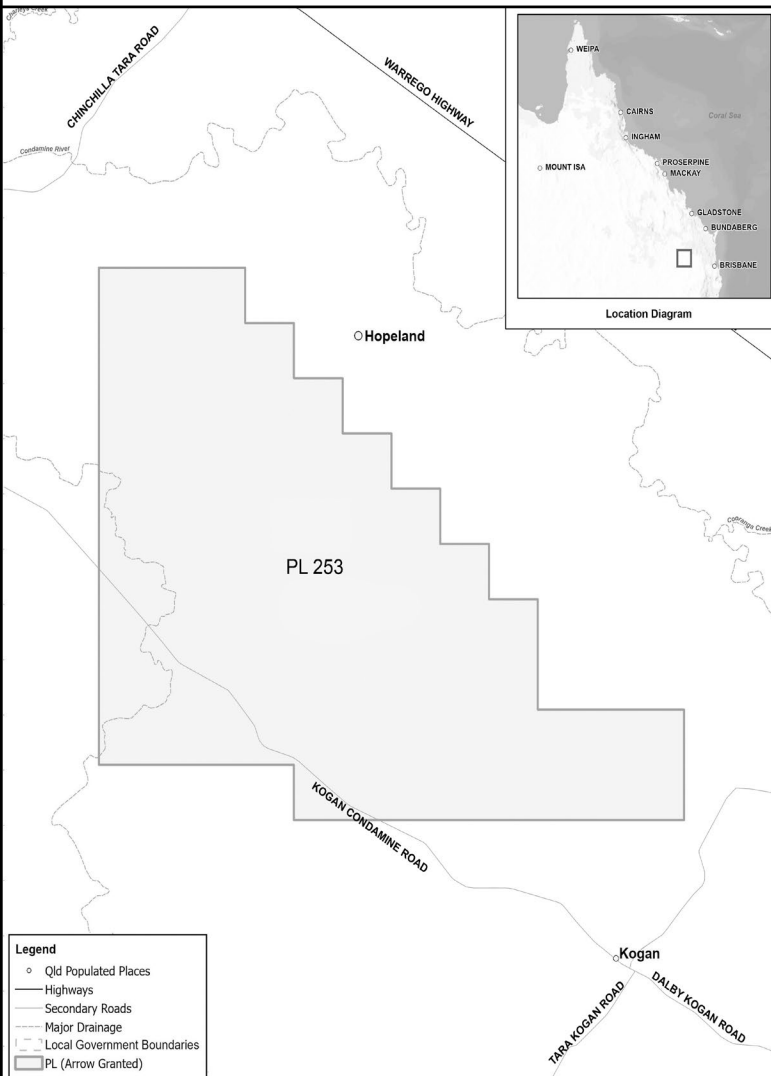


Figure 1: Location of PL253 / EA0001401

Resource activity: Site specific petroleum activity

It is advised that Arrow CSG (Australia) Pty Ltd has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The environmental authority being amended is EA0001401 associated with Petroleum Lease (PL) 253 in the Surat Basin.

The application relates to the Hopeland development area approximately 25km south of Chinchilla, 14km north-west of the township of Kogan, within the Western Downs Regional Council Local Government Area in Queensland. This resource activity involves the development and operation of Coal Seam Gas (CSG) wells, gathering lines, and associated infrastructure. The land on which the development is proposed is shown in Figure 1.

Amendments to the existing environmental authority EA0001401 are proposed to authorise Stage 2 of the Hopeland development. This will require amendments to the scale of authorised CSG activities and changes to authorised impact areas for Prescribed Environmental Matters, Matters of State Environmental Significance, and impacts to Category B and Category C Environmentally Sensitive Areas.

The application documents consist of the environmental authority amendment application form and

supporting information reports with appendices on biodiversity impact assessments, groundwater impacts, and spatial files.
